VENUE INFORMATION

Some useful information to help you get the most out of your visit to the Theatre

The Festival Theatre is an open air venue set in a magical location in the award winning gardens of Hever Castle in Edenbridge, Kent. The stage is fully covered and the seating is tiered with the vast majority of seats under new seating canopies, which means if the sun doesn't shine, the audience can still enjoy the spectacular setting with protection from the weather.

GATE OPENING TIMES

Evenings: Gates open 6.30pm, Performances start at 8pm

Matinées: Gates open 1.45pm, Performances start at 2.30pm, Exit by 6pm

FOOD AND DRINK

Audiences are welcome to picnic in the Castle grounds before evening, and after matinée performances; either in the idyllic lakeside setting or on the Theatre lawn itself surrounded by stunning flower beds.

Pre-theatre suppers are available on the evening of performances in the Guthrie Pavilion Restaurant with earlier access to the grounds for those who have booked suppers in advance. A snack food counter and bar are also available pre-performance and during the interval.

Cream Teas are served in the Guthrie Pavilion following the matinée performances of the two plays. To make a reservation please call the Box Office.

LOCATION AND PARKING

The Theatre is located in the grounds of Hever Castle, which is situated 3 miles south east of Edenbridge off the B2026 between Sevenoaks and East Grinstead. It can be reached via junction 10 of the M23, and is signposted from junctions 5 & 6 of the M25 and the Hildenborough exit of the A21. Satellite Navigation Users: postcode TN8 7NG.

There is free parking available for cars and coaches near the Theatre.

ACCESS

The Festival Theatre aims to provide good access for all our visitors. There is disabled parking available closer to the entrance to the Theatre, the route to the auditorium is mainly paved, without steps, and Assistance Dogs are permitted into the Theatre Auditorium.

All visitors should be aware that we are an open-air venue situated in a Grade 1 listed Garden, so certain restrictions may exist. For individual requirements please contact the Theatre Box Office.







It has been dubbed 'the greatest year in Jazz' and there was definitely something in the air in 1959 ... Castro took over Cuba, Buddy Holly died in a plane crash, Pan Am started regular flights around the world and NASA sent 7 astronauts into space.

From Miles Davis' *A Kind of Blue*, Charles Mingus' *Mingus Ah Um* and Ornette Coleman's *The Shape of Jazz To Come* through to John Coltrane's *Giant Steps* and The Dave Brubeck Quartet's *Time Out* – 1959 saw the recording and release of perhaps the most influential jazz albums of all time, which would go on to change the face of jazz forever.




The Power of Love

Ruddigore by Gilbert & Sullivan

Following the runaway popularity of their previous G&S productions, Illyria celebrates its quarter century with another romantic summer opera to leave you with a haunting song in your heart. This G&S production is a glorious all-out spoof of both melodrama and the classic haunted-house story.

Robin Oakapple, a young farmer loves Rose Maybud but his secret is that he is really Sir Ruthven Murgatroyd, the rightful Baronet of Ruddigore in disguise. These Baronets are cursed and have to commit a crime every day or die an agonising death. When an army of long-dead ancestors emerge from dusty portraits to demand Robin/Ruthven's death might there be some kind of loophole by which he can dodge the terms of the curse and marry the girl of his dreams?

Ruddigore gets the complete Illyria treatment, faithfully performed by a reduced cast and accompanied by a Musical Director on keyboard. Despite the reduction in scale not a single word from WS Gilbert's libretto is cut, nor a single note or harmony from Sir Arthur Sullivan's score unsung.

Telephone bookings are accepted Monday-Friday, 9.30am-5pm. The Box Office is open from Monday 29th February for priority booking; and Monday 14th March for general booking.

IN PERSON (Performance evenings only)

The Ticket Office located by the Theatre is open on performance days for ticket collections and sales. It opens from 6.30pm for evening performances, and from 1.45pm for matinees. However we do advise checking availability of tickets before arriving at the venue

BOOKING FEES

There is a total booking fee of £3 per order placed by telephone through the Theatre Box Office. There is an online booking fee of 7% of the total order value for tickets booked online.

GROUP BOOKING

There is a discount of 10% for groups booking 20 seats or more for a single performance. Group tickets must be booked by telephone through the Theatre Box Office.

CHILDREN

For family shows a child ticket is valid for children between the ages of 18 months and 15 years. Children under the age of 7 are not permitted to evening performances that start at 8pm (with the exception of Rock Choir).

REFUNDS & EXCHANGES

Tickets can be exchanged up to 3 days before the performance. There is a £5 administration fee & the original tickets must be returned to the Theatre Box Office. Ticket exchange is free for Festival Friends.


All tickets are sold subject to the Theatre's Terms and Conditions which are available from the box office or can be viewed on our website.

SEATING INFORMATION

❖ There are 3 reserved seating areas, the Centre Tier on the ground closest to the stage, and the East and West seating stands. All the seats in these areas are tiered with two rows on each level in the Centre, and one row on each level in the East and West. All seats are covered with the exception of two rows at the back of the Centre Tier. These uncovered seats are available for £1 less than the covered seating price.

❖ Grass Areas either side of the stage are available for Musical Entertainment Shows. Audience can bring their own chairs and rugs to sit in these areas which are uncovered and unreserved. The view may be restricted.
